Dear parents and carers of children in year two and three.

On Wednesday July 3rd your children will find out who their teacher will be and which classroom they will have in September 2025. Transition mornings are always exciting for the children and this year will be no different. Your child will be able to come home that evening and tell you all about their new class.

In recent years, St. John's children have moved up every September as a single year group into single aged classes. In September 2025 we are going to have three mixed aged classes made up of children in year three and four. Your child will not notice a lot of difference. They will still have friends (old and new ones to be made) with them, have the same timetable and routines and enjoy out of class activities such as sports day and visits.

We understand that you may have questions about this and how we will continue to support your child in becoming the best they can be in their new class. With this in mind, we are inviting you to a parent and carer only meeting at 5pm on Monday 16th June at school where we look forward to answering them. Please note that this meeting is not for children, they will find out about their new classes on July 3rd, this meeting is for parents and carers only and is expected to last no longer than an hour.

However, to help with some initial questions you may have, we are happy to try to answer some of them below.

- The three classes will all be made up out of mixed ability, mixed gender and mixed year groups so that they are as equal as possible.
- Children will still be taught in line with the national curriculum, there will be no missed parts of the curriculum for any child.
- All children will have the enhanced opportunity to the work with the Music Partnership and will have a year of weekly music lessons and the loan of an instrument for the year.
- There will be no disruption to support for children that have EHCP's or IEP's and any support with extra teaching assistants will continue.
- Governors understand and support that this class structure for the school year 2025-2026 needs to be put in place.
