New class and teacher welcome evenings

As we did last year we are having our first parent evening of the year this month. The first meeting of the year is now going to be on the 17th or 18th September and will have the same format as the meetings last September. The second meeting of the year is going to be during the week beginning 2nd February and will be the traditional format where you have a private 5-minute meeting with the teacher.

In September, you are invited to come and spend time in your child's class and get to meet the teacher, who will be able to spend half an hour presenting general information about class procedures, routines and what teaching and learning will take place this year and most importantly giving you a longer period of time to really get to know your child's new teacher, rather than the few minutes we have in the traditional evenings. You will also be able to look at your child's first few pieces of work. *Teachers will also be able to briefly speak confidentially with you about your child if you wish.*

Please use the enclosed form and return it to your class teacher, letting them know which session you would like to attend so that we have an idea about how many parents will be in each session. You only need to attend one session for each class you have a child in.

Please remember that these parent evenings are not the only time you can speak with your child's teachers. Class teachers are also, often available, for brief conversations before school, however, it is better to see teachers at the end of the day when we have a little more time. Please be aware that we have our weekly staff meetings after school on Wednesdays and staff are unfortunately not available on this day. A senior teacher is also on the gate every morning.
