Unit 1 – Planets	- Name and label a map of the Solar System in Spanish. - Apply the rules of adjectival agreement to describe the Solar System in Spanish. - Use conjunctions and intensifiers to extend descriptions of the Solar System. - Ask key questions in Spanish in order to conduct an interview with an astronaut. - Answer questions in Spanish in order to present themselves as an astronaut. Deepen their understanding of adjectival agreement to describe themselves in terms of character.
Unit 2 – At School	- Repeat and recognise the vocabulary for school subjects. - Say what subjects they like and dislike at school. - Say why they like/ dislike certain school subjects. - Tell the time (on the hour) in Spanish. - Say what time they study certain subjects at school.
Unit 3 – The Weekend	- Ask what the time is in Spanish. - Tell the time accurately in Spanish. - Learn how to say what they do at the weekend in Spanish. - Learn to integrate conjunctions into their work. - Present an account of what they do and at what time at the weekend
Unit 4 – Me in the World	- About the many countries in the world that speak Spanish. - About different festivals (religious and non-religious) around the world. - That we are different and yet all the same. - That we can all help to protect our planet.
